We launched MFx last year, which grew out of our interest *in being a reflective practice* which not only designs and realizes buildings, but aims to learn from our built and unbuilt projects in a critical experimental loop. The "x" refers to an "extension" of the regular office, one that critically analyzes the work we've already completed and explores new trajectories. We've found that the enthusiasm and ideas generated by MFx WORKSHOP are just as valuable to the firm's work as our mentorship is to MFx participants.
