



## THE SAHARA

In a very direct and brief way we could explain that the Sahara is the largest warm desert in the world and the third largest after Antarctica and the Arctic. With more than 9 065 000 km<sup>2</sup> of area, it covers most of North Africa occupying an area almost as large as that of China or the United States. The Sahara extends from the Red Sea, including parts of the coast of the Mediterranean Sea, to the Atlantic Ocean.

All this extension can not be considered as a flat or wilderness as it develops deep dissected mountains as well as mountain ranges, some of them volcanic. River are mostly seasonal or intermittent, the only exception is the Nile River, which crosses the desert from its birth in central Africa to its mouth into the Mediterranean. Underground aquifers can sometimes reach the surface, forming oasis rivers. And dunes, of course, which can reach a height of 193 meters.



## INHABITANTS OF THE DESERT

In order to develop a dwelling in the desert we must certainly take a look at all those peoples who for centuries have lived in the desert and are a clear example of subsistence within this particular region. The villages Tuareg.

The Tuareg peoples, when moving, cover both their needs and their animals' needs, because they live in large family units that carry large herds under their care.

The tent of a nomad is a structure, a set of necessarily light and transportable elements, easy to manipulate, adapted to the territory where they must settle, that acquire meaning when they are assembled and conform an interior space, the domestic space. The store is not an inert structure that occupies itself in an unconscious way, as it happens in the houses of the Western world, in which the space enclosed by walls is given from the beginning and remains unchanged, but constitutes a body that must be formed at the end of each displacement, always preserving the characteristics that make it a comfortable and intimate place. The tent isolates humans from the vast desert space and infinite skies, protecting them in their integrity and warmth.



## PROJECT

The competition consists of the realization of a project that provides a new concept of housing in the existing environment based on the concepts of use of passive techniques that will provide a home with comfort and sufficient architectural quality.

It is proposed to intervene in this singular space, being at the participant's choice to locate where he prefers within this natural setting. The enclave does not have physical barriers that separate the area of action from the rest, that is, it will be possible to define the limits of the intervention.

The materials, techniques used to exploit the energy must be consistent with the medium being in essence a (re) evolution in what the "Tuareg stores" represents.



## PROGRAM

Because the homes of nomadic societies function as small family communities, housing should be developed that forms a small community nucleus of several families. This does not imply that different housing must be developed, but rather the possibility of different family unions or groups involving an expansion of housing. Therefore, the flexibility of housing should be taken into account.

The proposed program may include all the spaces that the participants consider necessary, where the minimum units are:

- Resting area (accommodation of at least 4 people - a couple and two children)
- Socio-cultural area (kitchen, dining room and rest area)

The project must be a unique place that produces its own identity in the area and that proposes a need to take care of the existing environmental balance.

The proposal must dialogue with the landscape and nature and that relates its inhabitants with this particular environment, where even the materials can be local and according to the environment or place.

This program is orientative and can be modified by the contestant.

Project freedom is absolute and the area of intervention is free, this contest proposes that the participant investigate the forms of intervention in a singular landscape - Study limits, scales, views, access, materiality are the keys to follow.

\*Being a contest on ideas, the participants are free to modify the given surfaces. This report must be taken as a reference for the necessary spaces so that the project is practical and as a measure for the total dimensions of the project. The participants can suggest new areas not included in this document, as deleting and combining some of the already mentioned.

## reTHINKING philosophy

reTHINKING Team proposes contests far from the pessimism, with high doses of freshness and joy, restless and expansive. Definitely, it aims to stimulate and shake the architects heads who seem to be asleep and restore dignity to the profession. Being optimistic over all.

The proposed competitions will be focused on 8 concepts which we think there is much to investigate and propose by architects.

We understand that architecture can not be classified, as a single project reflects on various concepts relevant to contemporary culture, but enhance several of these main research topics.

## MAIN CONCEPTS

### NATURE



Definitely Nature does not exist. We have just digitalized the last squared meter of the planet and we have it already inside our artificial (artificializador) pocket.

Landscapes made to be used, where function and architecture show up at the same time their natural and artificial condition.

Architecture and context. Establishing both terms would be again a duality, some kind of halfway between architecture and its context, an inevitable addition of both of them due to its mutual influence. It becomes a singular ecology, among which architecture and what existed before are discovered. Architecture adds as a landscape, it is landscape and not object.

### HOUSE



In a context prone to the standard the housing issue continues to be a strongly sclerotic field characterized by conventionalism and the repetition of archetypes and patterns based on an ambiguous "neolanguage" pseudofunctional and eclectic at the same time. A "sclerosis" that refers not only to those operations that are merely speculative but, on many occasions, to those that, using a commonly accepted expression, would tend to be described as "Cultured" and that would base their main source of inspiration on urban models based on tradition and repetition.

For much of the past two decades, this has been the main objective of official urban planning: the recovery or recreation of an urban space of traditional silhouettes whose recombination would have been entrusted mainly to a pragmatic and zealous order based on archetypal planning, as a primarily compositional and figurative action inclined towards the reconstruction of the fabric or, in the outskirts, to its evocation.

Today, however, it is possible to understand housing as a place closer to desire and versatility, to the quality of life and the suggestive fantasy of leisure, well-being and knowledge than to the habitual serenity or predictability of a conceived space only as a mere necessity or social appearance: a new housing raised, in short, from diversity and plurality, rather than from homegeneration and collectivity. ### DENSITY

Density is a critical tool, more linked to the dimensions and dispositions of the urban plan than to the traffic flows evoked by the relations between parts of the city. By processing the density, it is formalized in plan and section and its isolated areas and buildings are fixed "

## DELIVERY CONTENT RULES OF PRESENTATION

Participants must submit a single A1 (59,4 x 84,1 cm) horizontal orientation is the only accepted. The **registration code (order number, #0000 or #00000)** obtained at the time of registration must appear at the upper right corner. Remember checking the spam inbox. You must also choose a **Slogan** or title for your project which can be placed anywhere. Panels delivered without the code and slogan can be excluded from the competition.

The jury will evaluate the quality of architectural design and its clear presentation and general composition.

Shall not be required, although it will be appreciated, to solve the project construction or structural systems.

The project must be understood mainly through the artwork. In the sheet may be included text, although the presence of a large amount is not recommended. You can use either English or Spanish. The scale can be chosen by the participants.

## ELIGIBILITY

All students and architects or related professions anywhere in the world can participate in the contest. Participation can be individual or in groups, being eight (8) the maximum number of members. Team members can be from all disciplines (artists, philosophers, photographers, etc.), without being necessary, although advisable, the presence of an architect or architecture student. It is allowed that members are from different universities and countries.

The price of registration is the price that each participating team must pay, regardless of the number of members.

In case that one team or participant wants to submit more than one proposal for the same competition must register twice (or as many as want to present projects) paying the appropriate fee each time.

Under no circumstances should the participation of any juror, or anyone organizing professional agency relationship with any of the above will be accepted.

## PRIZES

A prize will be awarded in the 1st phase of a total of 3,000 € distributed as follows:

The jury will be revising all deliveries, where finally, it was particularly valued the reTHINK!NG spirit and the adequacy of the response to the problem and achieved goals, reviewing the response that each project gives to each concept, methodology and research accomplished.

In this latest round finalists, honorable mentions and the winners will be designated.

**The jury reserves the right to award proposals that do not comply any of the parameters of these rules as long as it represents an improvement in the project.**
