

NOTES

Date you plan to arrive Ghana

- (1) Costs: All international volunteers are required to pay for food and accommodation at the weekly rate of €70 plus 300€ as project contribution regardless of the length of your stay. The project contribution is waved for participants from Ghana and neighboring West African countries.
- (2) Course Credit: Nka Foundation will support students who have a specific research topic they wish to develop to earn college credit. However, the topic must be preapproved by Nka in advance of starting the research or service course. The specific criteria necessary to earn credit will also need to be coordinated between Nka and the teacher involved. If this is the case, please provide necessary information and the school contact person who will coordinate your study abroad course.
- (3) Schedule: We are flexible. Volunteers and site coordinator will work together to arrange a flexible work schedule. However, participants are expected to work and help as much as possible for the construction.
- (4) Keep in Mind: Our project sites are rural locations, most precisely deep in the village in Ghana, where the convenience of development has not reached.
- (5) Travel Information: Visa is required for most visitors from outside West Africa, which can be issued via Embassy of the Republic of Ghana in your region. For more travel information, you may contact the Ghana Tourist Board (+233 21 222153; http://www.touringghana.com.
- (6) Once the applicant has paid the participation fee and wishes to withdraw for any reason after the payment deadline, the workshop leaders reserve the right not to refund the fee. Only if the project budget was not reached, all participants will be refunded.
