Around 1900 participants from 88 different nationalities have participated in the Porto Academy programs. Our invited lecturers and guests have come from a wide range of origins and fields of action with more than 160 invited guests from 26 different nationalities.

Porto Academy organized 9 Summer Schools so far plus 2 Visiting Schools: Visiting Barragán in Mexico City and Visiting Kahn and Venturi Scott Brown in Pennsylvania (online due to the pandemic).
